

COURSE OUTLINE

UPK DEVELOPER – REFRESHER WORKSHOP

Course Overview

Designed for Developers that have previous, perhaps limited, knowledge of UPK, this course provides a refresh of key functionality. This includes how to refine content already created, manage authors and content as well as a deeper understanding of the Knowledge Center.

The exact objectives of this training are dependent on the learning requirements of the delegate. The content within this outline relates to features and functions within UPK Version 12.1 ESP 4, but can be adapted to suit earlier versions of UPK if required.

Delegates receive three months telephone support on all features and functions covered during the course.

Course Delivery

The short course is designed to be delivered as facilitated online learning and is divided into small, bite-sized lessons with a total duration of 6 hours.

Delegates have access to an experienced UPK Instructor throughout the course. The Instructor provides an overview of specific features at the beginning of each session and then delegates are given hands-on tasks to complete in their own UPK environment*.
